- Shinai Sizes: Shinai sizes are defined in the Youth Regulations and the Competition Regulations of the DKenB.
- Team Rules:
1. Teams of 3
2. Youth Team line-up:
1st fighter from category 2
2nd fighter from category 3 or 4
3rd fighter from category 4 or 5
3. Adult Team: 1 Dan holder + 2 Kyu holders (18+)
4. The Dan holder fights in **third position** and may **only** compete in the team category
5. Incomplete teams may register – teams will be completed on-site
- Kyu Examination: **Kyu examinations** (up to 1st Kyu) will take place **after the tournament**.
- Catering: Water and fruit provided. Additional catering will be available.
- Deadline: 11 October 2026
